



COOPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE INSTITUTE OF TROPICAL MEDICINE (NEKKEN) OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NAGASAKI - JAPAN AND THE FACULTY OF PHARMACEUTICAL AND BIOCHEMICAL SCIENCES OF THE AUTONOMO UNIVERSITY "GABRIEL RENE MORENO", SANTA CRUZ DE LA SIERRA - BOLIVIA.

PRESENTS:

1. That the collaboration and exchange of experiences and knowledge, as well as the provision of services between both institutions, are of greater interest for their social and cultural progress
2. That both institutions aim to promote mutual understanding to strengthen cultural ties and provide opportunities to expand experiences and horizons in academic, professional, extension and postgraduate.

For all these reasons, it has been decided to conclude the Framework Agreement for Collaboration between both institutions, according to the following clauses:

FIRST CLAUSE .- (BACKGROUND AND LEGAL FRAMEWORK).

1.1 THE AUTONOMOUS UNIVERSITY "GABRIEL RENÉ MORENO", The University was created by Supreme Decree issued on December 15, 1879, constituting the IV university district of the Republic of Bolivia comprising the Departments of Beni and Santa Cruz. On January 11, 1880, the University was declared established, based in the city of Santa Cruz de la Sierra, Bolivia, it is a state institution of higher education, public law, endowed with legal personality, own patrimony; Autonomy: academic, administrative, economic and normative in coherence with the constitutional precepts of the Plurinational State of Bolivia.

The Public University of Santa Cruz is named after the illustrious thinker, historian and writer bolivian Mr Gabriel René Moreno, it offers more than 56 careers, both at the undergraduate level as a senior technician in the modalities:

Face-to-face and distance learning; Currently the UAGRM, is the main reference for higher education in the Department.

The UAGRM has among its objectives to train professionals at the undergraduate and postgraduate level who are useful to the community, with quality, excellence and a high sense of ethics and to disseminate scientific knowledge with full freedom of thought, critical and analytical sense, oriented towards an adequate understanding Of the phenomenon of academic, social and cultural interest.

The UAGRM has the responsibility to ensure the good development of all the factors that make education, aiming at continually raising the quality of education.

1.2 THE FACULTY OF PHARMACEUTICAL AND BIOCHEMICAL SCIENCES, created through Res. ICU 46/2011, of May 19, 2011, with residence in the University Campus of Valenzuela Street, is composed of two careers: Biochemistry and Pharmacy.

The Faculty has as its fundamental mission the formation of qualified professionals to execute the missionary activities according to the needs of the society, to fulfill this objective it has implemented a scientific-academic philosophy that must be developed by the teachers and students, according to the dynamics of our days, for which it has updated laboratories and technologies, promoting the continuous interaction of academic programs with the Santa Cruz community, for complement the professional training the University established practices in the field of industry for the career of Pharmacy and Biochemistry.

1.3 The UNIVERSITY OF NAGASAKI is a National Japanese University. Its main campus is located in Bunkyo-machi, Nagasaki, Nagasaki Prefecture, Japan.

On November 12, 1857, Dutch Army surgeon Pompe van Meerdervoort began medical conferences in the Dutch language to the Ryojyun Matsumoto Medical Government and 11 other persons. This medical school called Igaku Denshusho is the origin of today's Medical School, as well as Nagasaki University.

The University of Nagasaki contributes to the improvement of a well-balanced society by transmitting its legacies of the traditional culture rooted in Nagasaki, cultivating a successful creative sense in students and developing an innovative science to world peace
